The Annual NSEG Thesis Award

What is it?

The Nepal Society of Engineering Geology (NSEG) celebrated its 7th year anniversary this year. On this occasion, the “**Annual NSEG Thesis Award**” was announced and will be presented during the closing ceremony of **ARC-15 of the International Association for Engineering Geology (IAEG)**. The **Award** stands as a prestigious award planned to promote excellence in the fields of engineering geology, geology, and geotechnical engineering. This award is specifically aimed at individuals who have successfully completed their MSc Thesis in Engineering Geology related topics from the universities of Nepal. **The recipient of this award will not only receive a certificate of recognition but also a substantial prize of NRs. 25,000.** Additionally, the awardee will have the opportunity to become a member of the Young Engineering Geologist Group (YEG) within the International Association for Engineering Geology (IAEG) and the Environment through YEG group affiliation with NSEG. **NSEG will also cover the membership fees of IAEG for the duration of the 3 years.**

Who is eligible?

Eligible candidates should hold an MSc degree in Engineering Geology or Geology or Geotechnical Engineering and should possess less than 2 years of post-graduate experience as of the submission deadline. One *Male* candidate and One *Female* candidate will be selected for the award and the application will be evaluated by the award selection committee of NSEG.

When?

All applications must be submitted by 5 PM on November 25, 2025, via email to nsegnepal@gmail.com.

How to apply?

To apply, complete the provided application form and include a 2-page abstract that can contain both text and figures. Recent graduates with MSc degrees in Engineering Geology, Geology, or Geotechnical Engineering are encouraged to apply for this prestigious award. It is essential that the applicant's thesis primarily revolves around the theme of Engineering Geology.

The successful candidates will be informed by November 27, 2025, and they must be present at the ending ceremony of ARC-15 of IAEG at 5 pm on November 29, 2025.
