The NSEG Engineering Geology PhD Award

What is it?

The Nepal Society of Engineering Geology (NSEG) celebrated its 7th year anniversary this year. On this occasion, the “**NSEG Engineering Geology PhD Award**” was announced and will be presented during the closing ceremony of **ARC-15 of the International Association for Engineering Geology (IAEG)**. The **Award** stands as a prestigious award planned to promote excellence in the fields of engineering geology, geology, and geotechnical engineering. This award is specifically aimed at individuals Nepali Citizen who have successfully completed their PhD degree in Engineering Geology related topics from any university. **The recipient of this award will not only receive a certificate of recognition but also a Gold Medal.** Additionally, the awardee will have the opportunity to become a member of the International Association for Engineering Geology (IAEG) and the Environment through NSEG. **NSEG will also cover the membership fees of IAEG for the duration of the 3 years.** All the awardees will be invited in NSEG lecture series also to disseminate their findings.

Who is eligible?

Eligible candidates should hold a PhD Degree in Engineering Geology or Geology or Geotechnical Engineering (specialization Engineering Geology related topics) and should possess less than 2 years of PhD degree completion as of the submission deadline. This award will be given to all the applicants who meet the criteria. The application will be evaluated by the award committee of NSEG.

When?

All applications must be submitted by 5 PM on November 25, 2025, via email to nsegnepal@gmail.com.

How to apply?

To apply, complete the provided application form and include a 3-page abstract that can contain both text and figures. Recent graduates with PhD degrees in Engineering Geology, Geology, or Geotechnical Engineering are encouraged to apply for this prestigious award. It is essential that the applicant's thesis primarily revolves around the theme of Engineering Geology only.

The successful candidates will be informed by November 27, 2025, and they must be present at the ending ceremony of ARC-15 of IAEG at 5 pm on November 29, 2025.
